No, only the marks scored in the mains and interview round will be considered for final selection.

ANY SECTIONAL CUT OFF FOR EACH SECTION IN IBPS RRB EXAM?

Yes, each candidate will be required to obtain a minimum score in each test of Online Prelims and Mains examination to be considered to be shortlisted for next round.
